Rather than using the lectionary readings as a source for building the themes, that candle-lighting order draws on the themes of hope, peace, love, joy, and good news. First Sunday of Advent (Focus: Isaiah 64:1–9) Reader 1: O God, we light the first candle of Advent. (A member of a family lights the first candle.) Reader 2: We kindle it with hope. We long for you to come to our world, to break through and reign with compassion, justice, and peace.

Fourth Sunday of Advent. On this fourth Sunday of Advent, as we think about the coming of Jesus Christ, we light the candle of love. How great is the love the Father has lavished on us! (1 John 3:1) This is how God showed His love: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him. (1 John 4:9)

On the first Sunday of Advent, the first purple (or violet) candle is lit. This is called the "Prophecy Candle" and recalls the prophets, particularly Isaiah, who foretold the birth of Jesus Christ. It represents hope or expectation of the coming Messiah. Each Sunday following, an additional candle is lit.
